


GAB guided home schooling beats our expectations!

We could only use cell phones and FB Messenger and YouTube. Most of them did not have decent study spaces in their austere homes. Moreover, many parents did not have the opportunity to have advanced education.



But halfway through the school year, everyone was still very happy with their GAB! Zero drop outs! God is good!

Teacher Maribel is a miracle worker! In four months the 4-year-olds began reading and writing simple words. More importantly, both parents and children remained enthusiastic with their daily lessons, building positive attitudes toward education.



We ask each parent to send in a picture of her child and his or her seatwork, everyday. This is part of the attendance report. At the same time we get necessary feedback on the children's wellbeing and their progress.
