The 4-year-olds learned how to read, write and do simple math, and most importantly saw their meaningful roles in their family and community.



Like we always said, Teacher Maribel is truly a miracle worker. Using only FB Messenger and YouTube because the children can only borrow their mother's cell phone with minimal load, she had everyone having fun while learning.



We distributed nine weeks of worksheets and school supplies before the school year started. We're so happy to see how the Spirit leads us. Everything just fell into place!





Every school day, each student is asked to submit a picture via UCH Messenger groupChat, a picture of the day. This serves as attendance in the roll call. Everyone is happy to send one.

## Another good year!


